

## Current Issues in Manure Management

*This workshop meets the educational requirements of the Commercial Animal Waste Technicians Licensure program **but will also be useful to others involved in the current issues and practical aspects of manure application.***

Licensed commercial manure applicators are responsible for a growing percentage of the total manure applied in Minnesota. Currently there are approximately 300 commercial manure applicators licensed in Minnesota with more requests for licensure each year. This licensure program is a critical factor in insuring livestock and poultry manure is applied in an environmentally sound manner and in accordance with Minnesota feedlot regulations.
